1. Overview

Maps CTL modules or objects to a list of nodes upon which they are specified to reside. The `nodedispach` strategy specified by the [execute](#) tag uses this file to look up if the command should be executed locally or remotely. See the [Node Dispatch](#) section for general info.

This configuration file is located within the "etc" directory of the depot (eg, `$CTL_BASE/depots/<project>/etc/deployments.properties`). See the project [setup](#) for guidelines on how to manage the file centrally.

The format of the file is described as shown below:
